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**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION**  
(Under Chapter 1702 of the Ohio Revised Code)  
Non-Profit Corporation

The undersigned, desiring to form a corporation, not for profit, under Sections 1702.01 et seq. of the Ohio Revised Code, do hereby state the following:

**FIRST.** The name of said corporation shall be Percy Lee Brown, Jr.

Memorial Scholarship Fund

**SECOND.** The place in Ohio where its principal office is to be located is Reynoldsburg

Franklin County, Ohio.
